



Skiwi Ski & Social Club RACING JOB DESCRIPTION

- 1) To coordinate and expand all ski race related activities. These activities can include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a) Gain knowledge of race events and activities sponsored by local organizations that are involved with ski racing.
 - b) Social gatherings for racers and potential new racers to promote the racing program and recruit new members.
 - c) Gather information on lodging for racers and coordinate reservations. (This may include sending in deposits for condo's or reserving rooms at a local hotel.)

- 2) Act in the capacity of "Race Representative" within the race organization the club participates with. As of the 1996 season, the club participates in the Michigan Alpine Competition Council (MACC), which is a member organization of the Metropolitan Detroit Ski Council (MDSC). Responsibilities of the Race Rep include the following:
 - a) Inform MACC of your role as Race Rep and provide your mailing address and phone numbers to them. This needs to be done right after the April changeover meeting to ensure all racing correspondence is properly received.
 - b) Attend MACC meetings or send a representative in your place. The MACC meets regularly from October through April, with the bulk of the meetings taking place during the actual ski race season, which is from January through March.
 - c) Attend jury discussions held on the race hill, if there are any disputes from the race team members.
 - d) Keep team members informed of rule changes and coach new members to help them learn the rules.
 - e) Coach team members with their duties to fulfill their work assignments. (i.e. gatekeepers, timers, starters, etc.)
 - f) Pick up racer bibs from MACC and distribute to team members.

- 3) Keep the Board and General Membership up to date with race related activities. This should be done with, but not limited to, the following means:
 - a) Inform Ski Committee of Race Schedule as soon as it becomes available. This is usually ready in April.
 - b) Regular announcements at the General Meetings. During the race season, give race results. During the "off" season, announcements about the team should be made beginning around September to let people know the team is looking for new members, or having a "racer" party. This will help to keep people thinking about the race team and to spark interest.

- 4) Participate in the MACC Ski Race program and ski really fast while making all your gates!
